

Frequently Asked Questions for Insureds

What should I do if the provider does not recognize the VUMI® membership card? Let them know that VUMI® uses the Aetna network or ask the provider to contact VUMI®.

What should I do if the provider asks me to pay?

Do not pay. Contact a VUMI® medical coordinator immediately, available 24 hours a day.

What happens if for some reason I have to pay for the consultation directly?

You must send invoices and payment receipts to VUMI® for a full refund.

Does the deductible apply?

No, the deductible will not apply to services received at convenience or walk-in clinics.

Is there a limit of visits allowed to these clinics?

There is no restriction of visits. You can receive unlimited medical services at convenience or walk-in clinics and without the application of deductible.
